Recently, a fraudulent email case was reported that the email sender claimed to be a banking staff, inviting the recipient to pretend to be the next of kin of a deceased client who has left a huge sum of unclaimed fixed deposit. Upon receiving favourable reply, the fraudster requested the recipient to disclose the recipient 's personal information for further communication.
